

CNOR Prep and Review Course

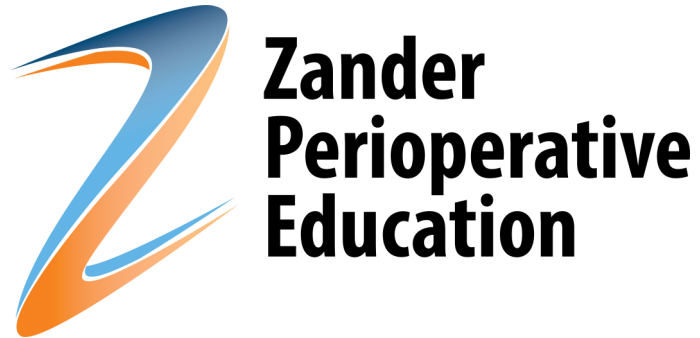
This two day course is designed to prepare perioperative nurses to take the CNOR exam and to demonstrate clinical competence and knowledge of practice standards.

Course Benefits:

The CNOR exam is a perioperative exam, covering preoperative, intraoperative, and postoperative nursing. Since many nurses specialize in only one of these areas, it is vital to understand the rationale behind the entire perioperative nursing process from start to finish. We will discuss several topics over the two days of class; all aspects of sterilization the safe administration of anesthesia, the nurse's role as a patient advocate, and the professional nurse's responsibilities both ethical and legal, all from the perspective of the perioperative nurse. The discussion of each topic that we present is carefully and consistently tailored to reflect the most up to date version of the exam. This class will help you develop not only the understanding that you will need to pass the exam, but also develop confidence and clinical competence in your own nursing practice.
